As most restrictions are now lifted from schools, we are now able to offer a 'normal' school week. This means that ALL children will be attending school from 8.50/9am-3.15pm including Fridays! I'm sure like us, many of you are really pleased that we are able to resume normal school hours.


As you will now be aware, our site is more or less back to normal with movement in both directions around the building. However, I would like to reassure you that we will continue with some additional precautions in school to minimise risks around Covid 19 as follows:

- Hand sanitiser in all classrooms for frequent use.
- Continuation of reminding children to 'Catch it/Bin it/Kill it' with tissues available and lidded bins in all classrooms.
- Anti bacterial wipes available in all classrooms for staff to wipe down desks etc as required.
- All classrooms have ventilation strips on the windows so even if they are closed air is circulating. Windows will be opened as required and during colder days, when the children are out playing to blast air through.
- Minimising parents in the school building – if you need to go to the office please be patient as you may need to wait to limit the number of people in the entrance.

As always, the welfare of our pupils and staff is paramount and we will continue to follow guidance set by the Government and Public Health England.
