Early Years: Children achieving GLD

Context: A significant number of pupils arrive in Reception with poor speech and language, social skills and self regulation. They make strong progress in Reception and by the end of their Reception year, data is line with National or above.

The 2022/23 cohort/class in Reception was a small cohort with above National percentage of EHCPs and SEND.
